

Tech Program provides an opportunity for nursing students to further develop critical thinking and decision making skills while providing them with exposure to the continuum of care. It also provides mentoring and additional educational opportunities while supporting the progression from nursing student to Registered Nurse.

#### The Nurse Tech program includes:

- An individualized and comprehensive nursing orientation process that is designed with your needs in mind.
- An opportunity to apply the fundamentals of nursing and put Medical-Surgical theory to practice while refining Medical-Surgical technical skills under the supervision of an experienced Port Huron Hospital Registered Nurse.

#### Candidate qualifications:

- Nurse Techs are nursing students who have completed a Fundamentals of Nursing course, Medical-Surgical theory and one Medical-Surgical clinical rotation.
- Students must be enrolled in an accredited nursing school program.
- Students must be in good academic standing with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA.
- Students must plan to graduate within one year.

#### The Nurse Tech role:

- As a Nurse Tech, you will have the opportunity to observe and work under the direct supervision of a Registered Nurse and begin to use the technical skills you are learning in school in the "real world" environment.
- At Port Huron Hospital, Nurse Techs have the opportunity to work in a variety of specialty areas including: Medical/ Surgical, Orthopedics/Oncology, Telmetry/Stepdown, Intensive Care, and the Emergency Department.

#### Work schedule:

 Each week Nurse Techs will have the opportunity to work two shifts per week with monthly case study days being a 12-hour shift.  Our leadership recognizes the need to offer flexible schedules to busy students and will strive to provide the best learning experiences for you.
